Recipes for the Grace Lutheran Cookbook

Kuchen (coffee cake) Carla Peterman

This is a recipe I received from my mother in law Connie Callsen Peterman. It comes to her from her mother in law Grace Schroeder Peterman who got it from her mother Elizabeth Kluetz Schroeder (great grand mother to Mike Peterman). It's a good base sweet dough that I use for Swedish tea ring or sweet rolls. It's easily modified for bread machine if you prefer to make dough that way. The original recipe called for 3 cents of yeast.

2 packages yeast dissolved in 1/2 c warm water. Add 1 tsp sugar

Beat 3 eggs in large bowl Add 1 tsp vanilla 1 tsp nutmeg

Scald 1 cup milk Add 3/4 cup sugar 1/4 cup butter

Let this mixture cool then add to beaten eggs, then add yeast mixture and mix well

Add about 5 cups flour and beat. (This is a wet dough. If you plan to use for rolls, add enough flour to make it workable.) Let rise until double in bulk. Divide in three parts. Knead each part and put into greased pans. Spread with melted butter. Sprinkle with cinnamon and sugar. For apple kuchen place sliced apples on top before spreading butter, add a little sugar. Cover and let rise. Bake at 375 for 15 - 20 minutes.
