We are getting ready to take Reservations for indoor worship on June 13, 9:00 a.m.! Things to know:

- Reservations are on a first come/first served basis, capped at 14 individuals or groups. A "group" is defined as people who are comfortable sitting together without distancing. Because of space limitations this can be no more than 7 people. If you have more than 7 people in your group you will need to create an additional reservation.
- The sign-up will be available the Monday before each service (see the <u>website news section</u>). We are not able to accommodate standing reservations, you will need to renew your reservation each week.
- If you need wheel chair accommodations, please tell Emma directly at emma@gracedm.org or by calling the church office. This will NOT impact your ability to reserve space, it simply allows us to know specifically where to seat you.
