Today, Sunday January 12: Contemplative Practices and Labyrinth Walking

Being New and COCI (Contemplative Outreach of Central Iowa) warmly invite you to walk the labyrinth set up in Grace Hall. This will be available from 10 a.m. until noon.

Labyrinth walking is an ancient practice used by many faiths for centering, contemplation, and prayer. Entering the serpentine path of a labyrinth, you stroll while quieting your mind and focusing on a spiritual question or prayer, walking first toward the center and then out again. There is no right or wrong way do this. Often walkers set an intention, sometimes with the sense of letting go of what it is time to shed on the walk in, opening oneself to inspiration or guidance in the center, and then emerging back into life, renewed, refreshed, ready to live into the next unfolding steps of life. An excellent way indeed to start a new year.
