Larger boxes and paper grocery sacks are nice for transporting larger harvests to the food pantries, and carrying stacks of smaller containers to the Little Free Pantry.

- Fruit containers & clamshells
- Berry baskets/punnets (pint sized or larger)
- Paper grocery sacks with handles
- Printer paper boxes or smaller shipping boxes
- Cardboard flats from produce or greenhouses, cardboard shipping boxes
- Washed and dried plastic takeout containers with lids
