Labyrinth and Meditation Garden

A labyrinth and meditation garden is being planned for the grounds of Grace Lutheran Church, in the space of the former playground. For centuries, labyrinths have beckoned seekers of all traditions into stillness and presence. Unlike a maze, a labyrinth offers no wrong turns — only a gentle, winding path to the center and back, inviting flection, prayer, and renewal. This labyrinth will be **fully accessible**, welcoming people of all ages and abilities. While this significantly increases the cost, both Grace Lutheran and *Being New* are committed to radical hospitality and inclusivity in all we offer. The labyrinth will be surrounded by a meditation garden—a space of quiet beauty and spaciousness. A place to rest and reflect, and to remember that the journey itself is sacred. A devoted group from both the Being New Center and Grace has been meeting to shape this vision and guide its realization in phases, as funds allow. The first phase — the labyrinth itself — is hoped for this fall.



Ronald McDonald House Charities Pop Tabs!

I (Joie Gronert) have been saving pop tabs in a mug for several years. When the mug is full, I start a small baggie or add to a partial one. Others participate because every so often baggies of tabs appear on the counter in the pop machine room. I deliver the baggies to the Ronald McDonald House when I am nearby. Ronald McDonald House Charities collects pop tabs from cans (soda, soup, pet food, etc.) to raise money for programs that support sick children. The collected tabs are taken to a recycling center where they are weighed and sold for their aluminum value. It takes approximately 1000 tabs to equal a pound. 1 pound sells for approximately 50 cents. That doesn't sound like much unless many participate.
