in the past few years, the late Christmas Eve service has been very sparsely attended. Moving the time from 11 p.m. to 10 p.m. to 9 p.m. over recent years has not made an impact and attendance remains small – often limited to the families of those who are serving. We tried offering several early evening options as well, thinking perhaps we would have several fully attended early services. The results were a fully attended 4 p.m. service and a sparsely attended 6 p.m. service. Christmas Eve worship just isn't the same when there are only a few people singing the hymns, especially if the attendees are only staff, Altar Guild members, musicians, and the Tech Crew.
